Navratri Puja Process

Navratri, the festival of nights, lasts for 9 days with three days each devoted to worship of Ma Durga, the Goddess of Valor, Ma Lakshmi, the Goddess of Wealth and Ma Saraswati, the Goddess of Knowledge. During the nine days of Navratari, feasting and fasting take precedence over all normal daily activities amongst the Hindus. Evenings give rise to the religious dances in order to worhip Goddess Durga Maa.

1st – 3rd day of Navratri

On the first day of the Navaratras, a small bed of mud is prepared in the puja room of the house and barley seeds are sown on it. On the tenth day, the shoots are about 3-5 inches in length. After the puja, these seedlings are pulled out and given to devotees as a blessing from god. These initial days are dedicated to Durga Maa, the Goddess of power and energy. Her various manifestations, Kumari, Parvati and Kali are all worshipped during these days. They represent the three different classes of womanhood that include the child, the young girl and the mature woman.

4th – 6th day of Navratri

During these days, Lakshmi Maa, the Goddess of peace and prosperity is worshipped. On the fifth day which is known as Lalita Panchami, it is traditional, to gather and display all literature available in the house, light a lamp or 'diya' to invoke Saraswati Maa, the Goddess of knowledge and art.

7th – 8th day of Navratri

These final days belong to Saraswati Maa who is worshipped to acquire the spiritual knowledge. This in turn will free us from all earthly bondage. But on the 8th day of this colourful festival, yagna (holy fire) is performed. Ghee (clarified butter), kheer (rice pudding) and sesame seeds form the holy offering to Goddess Durga Maa.

Mahanavami

The festival of Navratri culminates in Mahanavami. On this day Kanya Puja is performed. Nine young girls representing the nine forms of Goddess Durga are worshiped. Their feet are washed as a mark of respect for the Goddess and then they are offered new clothes as gifts by the worshiper. This ritual is performed in most parts of India. (process explained)

SHRI ArTHA ARGALA STOTRA

The Shri Artha Argala Stotram is another one of the innvocation Mantras of the Shri Durga Saptha-shati. Where the Durga Kavach gives us the form of the Devi it is only then we are able to enter her Palace. This Stotram acts like a key or perhaps the sound of the bell which hangs at the door of a mandir, allowing us to enter the Mahal of the Devi.

So with hands clasped and a humble attitude we chant the auspicious The Stotram of the Devi as written in the Chandi Paath (also known as the Durga Saptha-shati) of 700 verses found in the Markandaye Puran.

Indiyanamadhishtatri, bhutanam chaakhileshu yaa, Bhuteshu satatam tsayai, vypti devyai namo namaha. - 27

Presiding over the **senses** of all beings and pervading all existence, to the Omnipresent Goddess who individualizes creation we bow, we bow.

Chitirupena ya krtsnametad vapya sthita jagat, Namastastyai Namastastyai Namastastyai namo namaha. - 28

In the form of consciousness she distinguishes the individual phenomena of the perceivable universe. we bow, we bow, we bow to her.

Kanya Puja in Navratri | Kumari Puja | Durga Puja

Durga Puja begins on the day of Pratipada and ends on the ninth day of the Shukla Paksha. This festival is celebrated twice a year i.e on first on Chaitra month and second on Ashwin month. Chaitra Navratra is also known as Varshik Navratra and Ashwin Navratra is called Sharidya Navratra. On the ninth day of the Navratra, Kanya Pujan is performed according to the rituals described in the Shastras. One improves his fortune by worshipping one girl child and salvation by worshipping two girls on this day. By worshipping 3 girls, one gets the devout mind and wealth, treasure by worshipping 4 girls, wisdom and success by worshipping 5 girls, six kind of achievements by worshipping 6 girls, kingdom by worshipping 7 girls, wealth and prosperity by worshipping 8 girls and domination of earth by worshipping 9 girls. Girls up to 10 years of age are worshipped in Kanya Pujan.

Rituals to perform Puja

Kanya Pujan is performed on Ashtami and Navami days of the Navratra. On the ninth day unmarried girls between the ages of 2-10 years are invited to have food. Girls who are older than 10 years of age are not considered for this Pooja. The number of the girls should be 9 in total equivalent to nine forms of the goddess or there should be at least 2 girls present while performing the Kanya Pujan.

Kumari Pujan

2 year old girls are considered to be Kumari. By worshipping a Kumari the devotee gets relief from all the pain and poverty.

Trimurti.

3 year old girls are considered Trimurti. The devotee gets a devout mind by worshipping the

Kalyani Pujan

4 year old girls are called Kalyani. The devotees get wisdom, success and all his desires are fulfilled.

Rohini Pujan

5 year old girls are called Rohini. The devotee gets relief from all the ailments and attains good health by worshipping Rohini.

Kalika Pujan

6 year old girls are called Kalika. By doing Rohini Pujan the devotee is able to defeat his enemies.

Chandika Pujan

7 year old girls are called Chandika. The devotee achieves wealth by performing Chandika Pujan.

Shambhavi Pujan

8 year old girls are called Shambhavi. By performing Shambhavi Pujan the devotees get relief from the poverty and wins in debates.

Durga Pujan

9 year old girls are called Durga. She protects the devotees from all the troubles and helps in accomplishing tough works. The devotees get freedom from all fears by worshipping Durga.

Subhadra Pujan

10 year old girls are called Subhadra. Goddess Subhadra looks into the welfare of the devotees. One achieves happiness on earth and in heaven as well by performing Subhadra Pujan.

Rituals to perform Puja

All these 9 girls portray and represent the nine forms of the goddess.

First of all, the feet of the girls are washed with water and are made to sit in a row on a pedestal. The girls are worshipped by chanting the Mantras. Then, Kumkum is applied on the forehead of all the girls followed by tying kaleva on their hands. Halwa, Puri and black grams are served to them. Once the girls finish eating the prasad the devotee touch their feet to get the blessings. Then give them some kind of dakshina before departing them. Goddess Durga gets pleased when the devotee performs Kanya Pujan with proper rituals and gives him freedom from all the troubles in his life
